#### CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

Payments can be made in instalments. Cancellation of booking after the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025 less the deposit is fully refundable until 60 days prior to tour commences, 8<sup>th</sup> April 2025. From this date the tour is 100% non-refundable. All visits, excursions, meals non utilised are non-refundable.
