


# LEMNOS GREECE | PART ONE | 30 APRIL - 7 MAY

#### DAY 1

Flight leaving Athens to Lemnos. Transfer from airport, go to accommodation, welcome meeting and pre-dinner drinks and dinner at Clover.

#### DAY 4

Guided tour with gentle walk to ANZAC Cove (looks over where ANZAC soldiers fought). Afternoon cooking class, dinner at Clover.

#### DAY 5

Visit other side of island, walk to the roofless church. Lunch at beach restaurant 'Manos'. Free time before dinner at Clover.

#### DAY 6

Free morning, picnic lunch, visit locals and learn about making feta cheese, honey and olive oil tasting.Restaurant dining in town for dinner.

#### DAY 7

Breakfast at the beach, drop off in town for last minute visit stroll/shopping. Time to say goodbye – pick up for airport Fly to Athens.

#### **INCLUDED:**

Flights 'Athens, Lemnos return', transfer and all transport on Lemnos island, accommodation, all meals (exception last day lunch), 45-minute massage per person, cooking class, wine tasting.

#### NOT INCLUDED:



Those staying on for part two in France will spend one night at accommodation close to the airport before catching flight to Paris CDG airport Day 8.

**Amiens** – UNESCO World Heritage Cathedral, 'the Hortillonnages – floating gardens, Saint-Leu 'the little Venice of the North', Jules Verne book lovers can follow his trail.

**Saint Valery sur Somme** – one of the most beautiful bays in the world and its charming medieval town, sailing/fishing harbour and estuary.

**Visit neighbouring Chateaux** – Compiègne/Chantilly.

### DAY 1

Leave Paris CDG for ouraccommodation. Settle in, welcome meeting, predinner drinks and dinner.

#### DAY 2

Visit Villers-Bretonneux: Sir John Monash Centre, The Australian National Memorial, The Franco-Australian Museum.

#### DAY 3

Day out exploring Amiens with its:

- UNESCO World Heritage cathedral
- floating gardens 'the Hortillonnages'
- Saint-Leu 'the little Venice of the North'
- Jules Verne book lovers follow his trail.

### DAY 4

Visit Pozières; one of the most significant sites for Australians on the Western Front, Bullecourt, the Lochangar Crater – site of the explosion of a huge mine signaling the Allied start to the Battle of the Somme on 1 July 1916.

### DAY 5

Day out exploring Saint Valery sur Somme and surrounding area.

### DAY 6

Visit Peronne with its Historical Museum of the Great War Thiepval with its memorial museum 'at the heart of the battlefields'. Froissy with its museum and take the 'little train of the upper Somme' in the afternoon.

## DAY 7

Day out in Albert: visit Somme 1916 museum with a guided tour of battlefields; Saturday Market– one of the oldest in France.

**DAY 13** Free day walking around Ermemonville and its gardens.

**DAY 14** Visit Chantilly and its Chateau.
